Title and practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	<p>Minors and young adults in the penal area and right to education</p> <p>There are 17341 juveniles in the penal circuit in Italy. 20% are minors of compulsory school age. Who is in charge of their training and education? The European Union-funded Happy Project, which has been running for two years, targets these users through the circuit of the Ufficio Servizi Sociali Minori and the Cpia. Curricular and extension workshops have been organized and are open year-round, including summer.</p> <p>Happy's partnership also enabled the renewal of the Protocol between the Centro per la Giustizia Minorile Lazio, Abruzzo and Molise and the Ufficio Scolastico Regionale per il Lazio on the issues of access to education for juvenile and young adult offenders and the launch of an interregional collaboration between the Cpia of Lazio, Abruzzo and Molise.</p> <p>The goal is to reach all youth in this condition and enable them to resume their abandoned school paths.</p>
Notes on didactical /methodological innovation introduced (max 1000 characters)	<p>The innovation of the project is the multi-level action of the partnership: taking charge of the minors, activation of a psychological support for parents, ongoing training of staff, activation of educational workshops also individual at the communities by teachers of Cpia 3 of Rome.</p> <p>Sixteen workshops were funded within social communities with 55 professionals for 90 minor offenders.</p>
