	The school is open from seven in the morning to late in the evening with activities that involve children of all ages and their parents, with a focus on the integration of parents of foreign origin and in particular mothers, who often still do not speak Italian well and tend to remain locked in their homes. The residents of the neighborhood consider the school as a point of reference, and the associations working in the area are in constant collaboration with it and with each other.
