Title and practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	Sharing and participation in the learning process If, on the one hand, art. 33 of the Italian Constitution grants freedom of teaching, on the other hand our school system constantly needs to foster more spaces to guarantee freedom of learning; in other words, students should be made more aware that they are in fact the active protagonists of their education, both sharing the didactic objectives and participating in planning research tasks, multimedia presentations and labs. CassanoScienza festival has represented an innovative form of approach to the study of scientific subjects closely connected to humanist studies, aiming at developing the students' cross-curricular skills and at spreading the idea of scientific citizenship.
Notes on didactical /methodological innovation introduced (max 1000 characters)	The "Oltre le Discipline" methodology offers teachers and students the opportunity to develop highly innovative cross-curricular projects to conduct science labs, workshops, MM presentations, in which STEAM subjects are combined in creative and attractive ways. Students are grouped together to work cooperatively according to the methodological principles of cooperative learning and inquiry learning; they have the opportunity to practice their "digital native" technology skills or acquire new functional skills for the "cultural product" planned in advance and discussed with their teachers. Special evaluation grids are used to monitor and evaluate the entire learning process.
