Practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	Disciplinary Debate integrates Debate as an innovative teaching methodology into the School Curricula. At 'Percoto' High School, and the schools affiliated with the Association "Academy of Argumentation and Debate of Friuli Venezia Giulia"*, the experience of Disciplinary Debate combines with the stimulating activity of the Debate Tournaments in the Alps-Adriatic region, held also in English - for the implementation of the CLIL methodology.
	History, Philosophy, Natural Science, Civic Education, are some of the main Disciplines that were protagonist in the <i>Debate</i> Tournaments (in 2020/2021 and 2021/2022) in Friuli Venezia Giulia region: thanks to the collaborative work of school Teachers and Head-teachers, working together as volunteers*, promoting and disseminating innovative teaching methodologies, spaces of inclusion and democratic participation for all the figures involved in educational processes were created.
	The positive collaboration with international associations of volunteers in the field of education made the implementation of the <i>Disciplinary Debate's</i> innovative active methodology for the recovery of language and <i>Oracy</i> even more effective and stimulating.

Notes on didactical /methodological innovation introduced (max 1000 characters)

The practice of the *Disciplinary Debate* is not an easy one, and the integrated use of this methodology in the School Curricula is neither immediate nor intuitive: however, it is an increasingly evident need, as it fosters an effective recovery of the students' articulated language and Oracy, effective interpersonal communication and meaningful and lasting learning. It requires serious training and constant practice to lead to extremely satisfactory results over time. In the classroom, the initially guided and less structured discussions become more and more structured, and they are stimulated and implemented starting from the reflection on the founding nuclei of the Disciplines and the construction of targeted disciplinary Curricula, which integrate the Debate methodology as a fundamental element of the practice of daily teaching. Collaboration and networking support of expert teachers and students, and the active and aware participation in the collective processes of innovation are important elements for the success and effectiveness of the Disciplinary Debate method - integrated in the Disciplinary Curricula.
