Title and practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	"Being ordinary is the real challenge" - Ordinary teaching activity in the multicultural classroom, where different learning skills and different abilities converge incessantly requires the employment of strategies of inclusion in the educational conversation. The aim is not to leave anyone behind, and to promote openness, collaboration, mutual recognition among all the actors involved, while preserving each individual's right to privacy as to the sanitary, psychological or socio-economic reason of their disadvantage (if any). Among several other factors, the role of the "teacher coordinator" is key to the success of the classroom as a "workshop of democracy", as the physical space of meeting and negotiation, which serves as an outpost against the risk of isolation, social exclusion, or even alienation. As most of the times the workings of all the subjects involved is self-effacing, the democratic enterprise of a well-functioning classroom may easily be taken for granted, but there are strong reasons to maintain that that is the place where democracy begins to happen.
