Title and practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	To be accessible, cultural heritage should not be merely seen and explained, but is should be told in its many facets. The story of an artwork, an artefact, a landscape could represent an inclusive space, capable of arousing interest and stimulating participation. This is the main aim of <i>Conversazioni d'Arte</i> : to promote cultura accessibility even to people with visual disabilities. The initiative is conducted by DC ERIC-Sed and the web radio of the Italian Union of Blind and Partially Sighted people (UICI). <i>Conversazioni d'Arte</i> is a project based on radio broadcasting to tell ou cultural heritage, make it known and heard by different publics, exploiting the ful potential of the radio. Every episode is enriched with pieces by ancient and modern authors, sections on initiatives accessible to people with visual disabilities and pillidedicated to the artworks of the State Tactile Museum Omero. The project was launched in 2011 and received the Braille Prize. It is now at its 14th edition dedicated to the common traits of the Mediterranean culture.
Notes on didactical /methodological innovation introduced (max 1000 characters)	The <i>Conversazioni d'arte</i> project's methodology could be easily re-proposed in different contexts and not exclusively on radio broadcasts, such as school classrooms or museums. That methodology is based on the increasing of the effectiveness of the treatment and transmission of themes and contents related to cultural heritage through the potential of the story, which is enriched by the contribution of documentary, literary and musical contents that contribute to the reconstruction of the cultural contexts. Within the methodological field it is interesting the use of storytelling techniques, or rather forms of reworking (subjective and narrative) that are inspired by historical events, lives of artists artworks, archaeological finds, etc. In that radio project have participated student in the context of Italian work-related learning (PCTO). In particular they were invited to develop narrative and multimedia products then presented on the radio.
