Title and practice/project short description (max 1000 characters)	<p>Tyndaris Agorà Philosophica - Festival of Philosophy and Classical Culture for an Aware Citizenship.</p> <p>1st edition: <i>Logos e Politeia</i>.</p> <p>Language e Citizenship, are the keywords around which the Italian Philosophical Society and a network of 13 high schools - headed by the Liceo "V. Emanuele III" of Patti (Me) - have built a training project that is also a Pathway for Transversal Skills and Orientation. It aims to offer teachers and students an opportunity for cultural and professional growth through participatory experiences of dialogue and enhancement of the historical-archaeological heritage of their territory. The project is divided into a first phase of philosophical-literary training in which a small civil lexicon is constructed with which exploring the founding values of democratic societies, knowing oneself, create meanings, develop ideas and design a plural, dialogic and inclusive society. In the second phase, teachers and students are the active protagonists of the festival, during which different experiences and practices alternate.</p>
Notes on didactical /methodological innovation introduced (max 1000 characters)	<p>During the festival, completely conceived and produced by teachers and their students, different experiences and practices take place, some of which are particularly innovative: from the philosophical café to the study seminar, from the philosophical speed date to the production of thematic podcasts, from the lectio magistralis to the interview-debate. The festival also aims to realise the fruition and valorisation of historical-artistic places in the area: from the ancient café of the early 20th century to the municipal villa, from the historical centre to the ancient Greek theatre.</p>
